How He Loves

I sincerely hope that you are enjoying our Lenten sermon series, "*How He Loves."* I've noticed that the love of Jesus seems to be a central theme in my preaching as well as in our ministry at Hillside this year. If you recall, we took an active look at "*Love Does"* in February as we focused on 1 Corinthians 13, commonly known as the "love chapter." We determined that giving and receiving love should resemble what the Apostle Paul describes: patient, kind, doesn't envy, doesn't boast, doesn't brag, isn't proud, doesn't dishonor others, isn't self-seeking, isn't easily angered, doesn't keep score, doesn't delight in evil, rejoices with truth, always protects, always hopes, always perseveres.

Paul based his adjectives on Jesus Christ, who is our model of love. Jesus loved without judgment, while at the same time did not accept sin. Jesus met people where they were and invited them to move where they needed to be. Jesus loved those he engaged for who they were and exactly where they were. However, he also loved them far too much to leave them as they were.

The same is still true. Jesus loves you for exactly who you are. Jesus will meet you exactly where you are. No change is necessary to receive the love of Christ. That is the message of the Gospel and that is Good News! There is no "but"! However, Jesus Christ loves you far too much to leave you as you are! The love of Jesus Christ, when it is received and embraced, is transformational! The love of Jesus Christ will change you!

As we seek to answer the questions: "Who is Hillside," "Who is God calling us to be," and "Who is God calling us to reach," we must first embrace the love of Jesus Christ, then experience a change in our own lives before we can engage our community by sharing the love of Jesus. What will that look like? We're still figuring that out, but I am confident that it will resemble what Paul describes in 1 Corinthians 13, and be lived out something like we read about in the Gospels. Let's begin by practicing Christian hospitality and "above all else, loving each other deeply, because love will cover over a multitude of sins" (1 Peter 4:8). -- Pastor Chris
