Hillside Little Lambs is where the foundation of faith begins for the smallest among us in the Nursery and Toddler Room. In April in the toddler room lesson will be *God's Good News*. Through story, song, and play we will be learning the bible is God's true story. Our bible verse is *2 Timothy 3:16 It (the bible) is useful for teaching us what is true*. In the Nursery, we will be exploring books with touch and feel pages. Children learn best through the senses, which engages discovery and wonder. Reading, sharing stories, and singing with a baby helps development in many ways. You're getting baby familiar with sounds, words, language, print and, eventually, the value and joy of books. This Mission project will start May 28 and end on August 2. We provide a balanced lunch for all children up thru 18 years of age. We will be serving at Lafayette Park, Princeton Creek Apts. St Joseph School, and Hazleton Community Center (1 day only) The meals are served on Tues. and Thurs. between 11:30-12:30 at each location. Meals are prepared in our kitchen and delivered to the 4 sites.

Hillside is making it our mission to reach out beyond ourselves. This is a great opportunity to serve others. We need 10-12 people each Tuesday and Thursday. The time commitment is approximately 1 hour plus time to drive to location. If you enjoy children and can hand out food items we have a spot for you. It isn't required to be there each meal. We can use you as often as you can work.

We have volunteers from the community and other churches along with Hillside. It is a state requirement that all the volunteers attend a training. The date will be announced later. Also, Hillside requires a current child safety check if you will be directly involved with the children. The charge for this is \$21.


