


DIRECTOR OF FAMILY MINISTRIES

One of my favorite holiday traditions is setting up the nativity scene in our living room. The girls help me unwrap each precious figure and we find just the right place to set Mary, Joseph, baby Jesus, and the onlookers.

This year, however, we're going to try something new with our nativity that I hope will add even more meaning for my girls. At the D6 Conference in Louisville, I had the pleasure of hearing Sarah Cunningham speak and share her new book *The Donkey in the Living Room.* This children's book will take us through the process of setting up our nativity during the 9 days before Christmas, rather than setting the entire scene at once. Each day includes a child's narrative from the perspective of each nativity participant. The grand finale, of course, is the baby Jesus, the one we've all been eagerly awaiting.

My hope is that this activity will provide even more meaning for my family and even more opportunity for us to talk about the importance of our Savior's birth not only for those who lived in Jesus' time, but for us and for future generations as well.
