There will be no meals in June, July or August to give all the folks involved a break. Questions? Contact Penny Mason at 812-779-7322.



The Hillside Relay for Life team is entering their final fundraising month for this year's project. Some of our activities and opportunities to help find a cure for cancer include:

Saturday, May 5 from 9-5 p.m. we will be having a bake sale at Walmart. We will be accepting any contributions of baked goods from the congregation to assist with this project.

Sunday, May 18 & 25 we will be selling Luminaries at church in Honor/ Memory of those who have battled cancer. We will also be registering Cancer Survivors who wish to participate in the walk and free meal on June 6. There is no fee for Survivor registrations.

Sunday, May 25 we will also be having a bake sale and refreshments between services.

Sunday, June 6 during both services; we will be having a moment of remembrance and lighting the Luminaries from our congregation.

Friday, June 6 at 6 p.m. is the Gibson County Relay for Life Celebration in the Pavilion at the Fair Grounds.
