CARING FOR KIDS

"CARING FOR KIDS" will start May 29 and end on August 2. We provide a balanced lunch for all children up through 18 years of age. This year we will be serving at the following locations: Lafayette Park, Princeton Creek Apts., St Joseph School, and Princeton Fire Dept. Station 2 located on White Church Rd. The meals are served on Tuesday and Thursday between 11:30-12:30 at each location. Meals are prepared in our kitchen and delivered to the 4 sites.

Hillside is making it our mission to reach out beyond ourselves. This is a great opportunity to serve others. We need 10-12 people each Tuesday and Thursday. The time commitment is approximately 1 hour plus time to drive to location. If you enjoy children and can hand out food items we have a spot for you. It isn't required to be there each meal. We can use you as often as you can work. We have some volunteers from other churches. Last year Hillside had 4+ volunteers. Some of the community volunteers will not be available this year due to family needs.

It is a state requirement that all the volunteers attend a training. It will be held at Hillside UMC on Monday, May 7 from 6-7pm. We will schedule one additional training. Please contact us if you want to help, but cannot attend on May 7.

Also, Hillside requires a current child safety check if you will be directly involved with the children. The charge for this is \$21. Please prayerfully consider if this might be one way you can reach out and share God's love.
